

s.s. "LA CRESCENTA" Enquiry.

A letter has been received from Mr. Moffitt, of Falmouth, advising that he has been instructed by the Solicitor to the Board of Trade to attend at this enquiry when called upon, and that the Board of Trade will pay railway fares and subsistence for a period of 2 days.

Mr. Moffitt adds that he considers it will be of great benefit **should** he be able to attend the Enquiry from its early stages, and submits that he may be granted leave to attend accordingly.

He also requests that the remaining week of his Summer holidays may be taken at the conclusion of the Enquiry.

The period over which it is estimated that the Enquiry will last is 12 days.

IT IS SUBMITTED Mr. Moffitt might be informed that with regard to his attendance at the Enquiry he should abide by instructions from Head Office, which he will be receiving shortly, and that with regard to taking the remaining week of his Summer holidays at the conclusion of the Enquiry, he will be at liberty to do so provided the work at his port will allow of this without any assistance from outside.
