Reverting to my letter of yesterday's date respecting the Inquiry into the loss of the s.s. "LA CRESCENTA", I have to acquaint you that there is a further paragraph in Mr. Marks' declaration upon which your comments are desired, namely :-

Para. 15 There was a ventilator over the forward end of the starboard alleyway of the after bridge It was about 6 or 8 inches in diameter It was broken off before I joined the ship and it remained so when I left The jagged edges of the coaming where it had been broken projected upwards from the deck and it was not plugged.
