It is noted that this Inquiry will probably be held at the Institution of Civil Engineers in October next, and that a further communication will be made in due course as to the actual date.


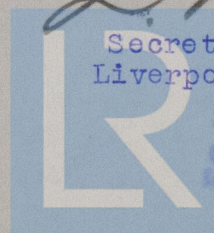
The copies of Liverpool Report No. 98508, on which the Surveyors mentioned will be required to give evidence, have also been received.
