
I was duly favoured with your letter of the 10th instant .....

In reply to the several enquiries contained in your letter I have to state that :-

(1) The particulars desired as far as they are available are detailed in the copy of the report for the assignment of freeboards in accordance with the International Convention which has already been forwarded to the Board. A photostat copy of the report of the Annual Freeboard Survey, held at Yokohama on the 23rd October 1934, is enclosed herewith. This report does not give any of the detailed information desired, but merely certifies that the Annual Survey was held and had been completed to the Surveyor's satisfaction.

On the 20th and 23rd October 1934, the port and starboard boilers were surveyed at Yokohama, when the boilers were found or placed in good order. Minor repairs were effected, but, as is usual with minor repairs, no details of the repairs are given in the report.

The Society's Surveyors at Yokohama is being

requested to state whether from hearsay or from his observations he had any reason to suspect that the hull, machinery, including the oil fuel installation and auxiliary machinery, steering gear or equipment were in a defective and unsatisfactory condition.
