Dear Sirs,

Reverting to your letter of the 28th June last respecting your steamer "ACHATINA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them today a report received from the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam, who have held a Modified Special Survey.

The Surveyors report that repairs have been effected to the bulkheads, framing etc., and I have to say that in view of the vessel's present condition as now reported, the Committee are agreeable to the vessel's class being maintained for a further period of 8 months, expiring at the end of February next.

The Surveyors also report that the Boiler Survey has been held at this time, and the Committee have assigned to the vessel a notation of B.S. 7,35.
