





Dear Sir,

With ^{further} reference to your letter of the 3rd instant relative to the Q.S. "BERMUDA", it has been ascertained from the Underwriters' representative here, Mr Smart of Messrs. Hay & Smart, that the examination of the condition of the vessel should be discontinued for the time being. It may be that later, authorization will be given by the Salvage Association for the Society's recommendations to be indicated, but apparently up to the present there has been no such authorization.

The matter is therefore being discontinued at a point when a final conclusion has not been reached. Should the matter be raised again a written request will be obtained, but in the meantime I have informed Mr Smart that I would be willing to assist him as far as I am able.


