DRYPOOL. — Tromsø, Nov. 9.—Hull trawler Drypool reported sunk outside Fuglo on Nov. 7.
Tromsø, Nov. 9.—The Hull trawler Drypool, returning from a fishing expedition to Bear Island, has grounded and foundered north of Tromsø. The crew of 14 have been saved and arrived here this morning.—Reuter.

Précis of particulars of Casualty

This trawler is reported to have stranded and sunk N. of Tromsø on the 7th November. crew saved.
The owners state that the vessel sank through striking a rock.
