Messrs. Peter Brotherhood Ltd., Peterborough, a three stage
steam driven air compressor for their motor vessel No. 570.


The compressor numbered 16650 was run upon the test
bench at Messrs. Peter Brotherhood's works for two hours
on 14th April 1920, running coolly and well with almost an
entire absence of vibration.

After the test the compressor valves were opened out
and appeared in good condition.

Result of Test:-

600 lbs per square inch.	3.5	354.	125 lbs per square inch.	5 lbs per square inch.
