H. I have to acquaint you that in March last the Society's Surveyors at Copenhagen reported that the Boiler Survey of the steamer "HAMMERSHUS" had been commenced by the survey of the main boilers, but that the donkey boiler had not been opened up for inspection as the steamer was to be broken up on completion of her voyage to Italy.

It would appear from the Shipping Papers that the steamer left Venice on the 13th ultimo for Pola, and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case attention and advise me immediately the work of demolition has been commenced.
