H. With reference to the Boiler Survey which became due at the end of January 1932 on the steamer "HAMMERSHUS", which vessel is now the property of The Italian General Shipping, I have to acquaint you that the Copenhagen Surveyors now report that the main boilers have been surveyed, but that the donkey boiler has not been opened up for inspection as the steamer is to be broken up on the completion of her present voyage, to Italy.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case attention and advise me immediately the work of demolition has been commenced.

You will observe that the screwshaft survey became due last January.
