With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "HIGHLAND HOPE", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them today a report from the Society's Surveyors here from which it appears that the vessel has been examined afloat on account of dragging heavily through the mud whilst on a voyage from La Plata to Montevideo.

Bilges have been sounded fore and aft, and the soundings recorded in the Log Books during the homeward voyage examined and found satisfactory, but it is recommended that the vessel be placed in dry dock for further examination at the first convenient opportunity.
