
Nature of Survey

The London Surveyors report this vessel examined afloat on account of dragging heavily through the mud whilst on a voyage from La Plata to Montevideo.

Bilges have been sounded fore and aft and the soundings recorded in the Log Books during the homeward voyage examined and found satisfactory.

The Surveyors recommend the vessel be placed in drydock for further examination at the first convenient opportunity.

It is submitted action be deferred and the Owners informed of the Surveyors' recommendation.
