On the 4th instant I received a note from them giving the tonnages and stating that they had applied for the fees, viz:-

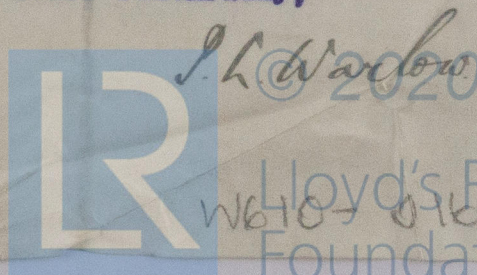
Entry fee	£12
