Dear Mr. Warlow,

With reference to Glasgow First Entry Report No. 48900 on the Motorship "HIGHLAND HOPE", you will have gathered from the letter which we wrote to you on the 31st ultimo that the survey for classification has been completed at Belfast, and the vessel's class assigned.

My attention has been called to the fact that the fees for the survey during construction of the hull do not appear to have been applied for, and in these circumstances I think it well to give you herewith the tonnage particulars obtained from the Ship's Official Register, viz:-
