Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the steamer "CALLANDIA" has been examined in drydock at Liverpool and the Boiler Survey held, and the Surveyors have been informed that she has been sold to Japanese buyers and is to be broken up at Osaka. In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will advise me as soon as the process of demolition is commenced.

I have to add that the Liverpool Surveyors have recommended that some damaged plating and the rudder, which is bent, should be dealt with in Japan whither the vessel is proceeding, and the class is therefore subject to this being done should she not be broken up.
