

S.S. "EMPRESS OF SCOTLAND".

24,581 tons.

This vessel was built in Germany in 1905 and classed with the Germanischer Lloyd.

She has been under survey at Hamburg for 4½ months with a view to classification with this Society, 47 visits having been paid to the hull and 45 to the machinery. The tonnage of the vessel is 24,500.

She has been fitted for carrying and burning oil fuel, and oil fuel tanks and settling tanks have been installed. 42 new furnaces have been fitted in the boilers.
