Messrs. the Atlaswerke A.G., Bremen, survey and test at their works the Evaporators Nos. 16291 & 16292 intended for the steamer "EMPRESS OF SCOTLAND". The Evaporators have been constructed in accordance with the approved plan No. 1431 and tested by hydraulic pressure of four kilogrammes per square centimetre and the coils and spare coils by an hydraulic pressure of thirty kilogrammes per square centimetre with satisfactory results. In my opinion the evaporators will be eligible for the intended working pressure of two kilogrammes per square centimetre when they have been examined under steam and their safety valves have been adjusted to the working pressure.

The Manufacturers name plates are fastened to the Evaporators by copper rivets and bear the identification mark:- No. 16291 & 16292, Atlaswerke A.G. Bremen, 1921, 2 kg/qcm. They have been stamped **R** on the rivet heads.
