This vessel was built in 1905 by Messrs. Akt.Ges.
"Vulcan" at Stettin and classed with the Germanischer
Lloyd.

Surveys of the machinery have been held by the
Liverpool and Hamburg Surveyors with a view to the
vessel's classification with this Society, and satisfactory
reports have been forwarded.

42 furnaces out of a total of 48 in the double
ended boilers have been renewed, and an oil fuel burning
installation has been fitted in accordance with the approved
plans.

Both screw shafts were examined in July 1921.

Plans of the boilers, shafting, pumping arrangements
and other details have previously been approved.
