In October last the Newcastle Surveyors stated they had been informed by the Owners that the vessel had sailed for Genoa and that the outstanding surveys would be carried out on her return, unless it was decided not to retain her in commission. In the circumstances the Committee deferred action in the matter for a time.

The Newcastle Surveyors now state the vessel is laid up indefinitely, and that no arrangements are being made in regard to the Special Survey which they will carry out before she again proceeds to sea if she remains their property.
