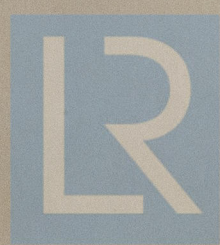

With reference to my letter of the 30th July last, I shall be glad to learn, as the vessel appears to have arrived in the port on the 6th instant, what action is being taken at this time in regard to the carrying out of the 2nd Special Survey No 3.	This vessel has sailed for Genoa and the Owners inform us that the 2nd Special Survey No. 3 etc. will be carried out upon her return in about five weeks' time unless it be then decided not to retain her in commission.
