NEWCASTLE-ON-TYNE.

Messrs. The Northumberland S.B.Co.Ld., Howdon-on-Tyne, survey the new S.S. "RUGBEIAN" built by this firm while in the Mercantile Dry Dock, Jarrow-on-Tyne, on the 29th. August 1904 for the purpose of ascertaining if any damage had been sustained by vessel stated to have grounded at Hartlepool on the 16th. July 1904 while proceeding from the Builders yard to that port to have her Engines and Boilers placed on board.

Upon Examination Found that no damage had been sustained but that the paint in several places was scrubbed.

Recommended that when the paint was found scrubbed the bottom be cleaned and recoated.

For the purpose of examining the bottom to ascertain if any damage had been sustained it was necessary to have the vessel placed in Dry Dock.

The above recommendation was made so as to place the vessel in the same good condition as she was in before the grounding.

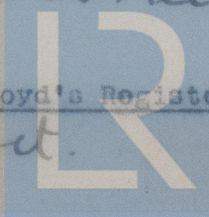
