The 1st S.S. No.2, due 5.30 has been partly held and a proposal to complete same next May has been agreed to.

Indented bottom plating in way of the forward deep tank requires to be dealt with at the first convenient opportunity.

The Yokohama Surveyors now report the vessel examined afloat on account of damage sustained to stem etc., through collision.

As the vessel was on the point of sailing it was arranged that temporary repairs would be carried out by the Ships' crew.

The Surveyors recommend the stem and stem plates below the waterline be examined at the next drydocking and permanent repairs carried out.

It is submitted action be deferred.
