The Newcastle Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock and the bottom coated.

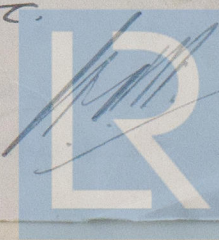
Shell plate E7 on port side has been examined and, in the Surveyors' opinion, the damage is slight and the condition regarding same might be removed.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 4.31. without special condition.
