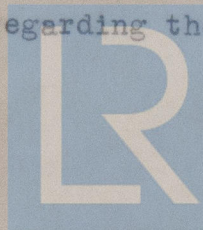
With reference to your enquiry letter of the 28th November and my reply of the 27th December last regarding the above vessel, I have to inform you that she has now been sold to:-


