"BONUS" I have to refer you to your letter of the 30th June last respecting this case and to say that as the letter of undertaking required by the Committee in respect of the overdue Second Special Survey No.2 has not yet been received from the Owner I wrote him direct from this Office on the 11th July and again on the 29th July.

Up to the present no reply has been received and in the circumstances the Committee will be glad if you will take an early opportunity of interviewing the Owner and point out to him that as the only condition on which the Committee are prepared to allow the vessel's class to remain undisturbed for the present is that the Owner will furnish the undertaking referred to, the case in the ordinary course will be again brought to the notice of the Committee, when unless the
