
Remarks of Survey

The 2nd S.S. No.2, due 4,31, has been partly held and a proposal to complete the same within the year of grace agreed to.

The Hamburg Surveyors now report that a visit was paid to the vessel with a view to advancing the survey, but nobody on board was in a position to discuss the matter and no part of the Special Survey was advanced.

An examination has been made of the decks, hatchways, ventilators and coamings, windlass, steering gear and its connections and found satisfactory.

It is submitted action be deferred.
