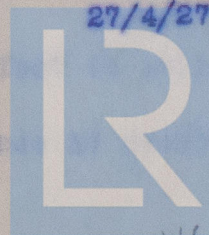
Fees and expenses amounting to Yen.370 (say 237) have been outstanding at Kobe since January, 1926, in respect of surveys held on the steamer "FUTAMI MARU".

As the vessel has now been abandoned as a total loss, and, in a letter dated 14th March, Mr. Cox states that he has made another effort to collect the account, but without success, and now sees no prospect of being able to do so, it is suggested that the account be regarded as irrecoverable and written off accordingly.
