D. Reverting to your letter of the 27th March, relating to the cast steel rudder of the s.s. "GALILEO", which had been condemned and replaced on account of two defects which had been found in it, I am directed to acquaint you that the rudder has since been destroyed, and that in the course of doing this another defect has been discovered, situated near the third gudgeon from the heel. This defect, although not previously visible, is found to be of a more serious character than the other two.


I enclose herewith a photograph of the last discovered defect, and I have to say that the Committee will be glad if you can furnish them with any further remarks on the subject.
