Dear Sir,

I beg to inform you that, at the request of the Superintendent, a survey was held afloat yesterday on the ex German steamer "Angermanälven", Number 51016, now owned by The Shipping Controller (J. J. Duncan & Co. Mgrs.), with the view to granting an Interim Certificate on form Cert. B.

The Superintendent stated that the vessel had been examined by the Surveyors to the Society in September last when a certificate for six months was granted; on this understanding the vessel was examined afloat (damage stated due to grounding on a sandy bottom) in a loaded condition, soundings were taken and the vessel found to be making no water, and it was arranged for an Interim Certificate to be issued, "subject to the vessel being dry docked at the first convenient opportunity, or at the next six-monthly Examination".

On referring to the Register Book later no reference to any Examination could be found but the

the Superintendent states he is certain that a survey was held by the Society's Surveyors.
