S. With reference to the Condition Surveys desired by the Ministry of Shipping in the case of ex-German Steamers being handed over to the British Government, I have to acquaint you that from communications received from the Ministry here, it would appear that the ex-German Steamer "SAUERLAND", No. 25733 in the Register Book has arrived at the Firth of Forth, and that the ex-German Steamer "ANGERMANELFVEN", No. 07181 in the Register Book, has left Germany for the Firth of Forth via Wisbech.

I have therefore to request that you will give these cases the necessary attention, and to add that the first-named vessel has been allocated for management to Messrs. Furness, Withy & Co., and the other steamer to Messrs. J.T. Duncan & Co.
