I am favoured with your letter of the 29th ultimo in reference to the overdue Second Special Survey No.1 of your steamer "ANSELMA DE LARRINAGA", which vessel is at present laid up in the River Fal, and note that before signing the form of guarantee enclosed with my letter of the 26th ultimo, you desire to know whether permission would be given to move the vessel from Falmouth to the Bristol Channel to carry out the necessary survey and repairs.
