UNDERTAKING CASE

The 2nd Special Survey N° 3 became due in July, 1932.

The vessel has been laid up & the Owners furnished the usual undertaking.

The Gothenburg Surveyors now state, in a letter dated 16th October, that as a result of their general examination (see Got. Rpt. N° 9518 attached) the Owners have abandoned the idea of sending the vessel to Italy to be broken up. The vessel has been removed to the yard of the A.-B. Lindholmen-Motala, of Gothenburg, & the work of demolition has now been commenced.
