This trawler went ashore at Medalland, on the south coast of Iceland on the 18th February; Lloyd's Agents per Salvage Association state "no salvage prospects," "vessel condemned"

In reply to a casualty notice the Owners state that although they have given notice of abandonment to the Underwriters, they have not yet been notified of acceptance. They add that the vessel will certainly be a total loss.
