## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

COMMACK (s.v.) - New York, Jan. 29. - American schooner Commack, Jacksonville for New York, ashore False Hook, Sandy Hook. Vessel in bad position. Part crew taken off by coastguard boat. Merritts gone to her assistance.  
 COMMACK (s.v.) - New York, Feb. 2. - American schooner Commack floated on Feb. 1 by Resolute; arrived.  
 COMMACK (s.v.) - New York, Feb. 2. - Diver has been employed to patch leaks in American schooner Commack.  
 COMMACK (s.v.) - New York, Feb. 3. - American schooner Commack will be placed in dry dock with her cargo. Diver cannot stop leak.

This vessel went ashore at False Hook, Sandy Hook on 20th January. She was floated on 1st February, and on 3rd February it was reported she would be placed in dry dock at New York with her cargo. Diver could not stop leak.

No report of survey has been received from New York.

An enquiry has been addressed to New York and the following reply dated 5th October has been received:-

"I am advised by the Bureau of Navigation Washington that this vessel is a total loss" "due to stranding off Sandy Hook N.Y." "January 20th 1925. This information is" "confirmed by the local Surveyor at" "Jacksonville, who has also taken the" "matter up with the Owners."

In the American Documented Supplement No 110 for June last, the vessel was recorded as "lost."

No casualty notice has been sent to the Owners in this case.

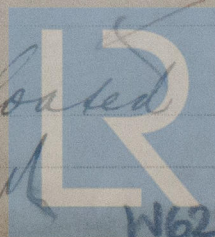
