Survey

The class is subject to the rudder mainpiece, repaired by electric welding 9.28, being specially examined at the next dry docking.

The Singapore Surveyor now reports the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, 1 shell plate and 2 deck plates renewed and minor repairs effected.

The rudder mainpiece, repaired by electric welding, has been examined and remains efficient and, in the Surveyor's opinion, the condition regarding same might be removed.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 6.30, without special condition.
