As regards the extent of damage to and the prospects of salvage etc. of the s.s."Orania" we beg to inform you that we gave notice of abandonment on the 22nd December last, so that the steamer in question is no longer our property and we therefore suggest your communicating with Underwriters who no doubt will let you know the information desired by you.

For your guidance we beg to enclose copy of a cutting from the issue of "The Times" of the 14th February referring to the fact that this vessel has been withdrawn from the re-insurance market and consequently considered a total loss.
