Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant having further reference to the Committee's requirements in regard to your steamer "CASSIS" as set forth in my letter of the same date, and note therefrom that you are agreeable to dry dock the vessel and submit her to a general examination throughout.

As regards the question you have raised respecting the testing of all the cargo tanks, I have to say that, in view of your statement that you propose to load the vessel with a cargo of a homogeneous nature, the matter has again been under consideration, and in the circumstances the Committee will be prepared to waive the testing of all tanks, provided the end bulkheads of Nos. 1 & 8 tanks be tested with satisfactory results, and also those of the pump room situated between Nos. 4 & 5 tanks.

I am therefore advising the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle to this effect.
