We are in receipt of your favour of even date, Ref. S.
regarding the above named vessel, and desire to thank the
Committee for the consideration given to the matter.

In reply, we beg to state that we agree to drydocking
the vessel, and to a general examination being made throughout,
etc. in order that the Committee can be placed in a position to
grant our request for retention of class in order to carry out
one of the proposed voyages.

In view of the fact that the cargo with which we propose
to load the vessel would be of a homogeneous nature, we beg to
submit that inter-tank leakage, if any, would be of no importance,
and to suggest that this part of the requirements be reduced to
testing the tightness of the end bulkheads of Nos. 1 & 8 tanks
and those of the pumproom, which is situated between Nos. 4 and
5 tanks.

to grant this request,
