The Glasgow Surveyors forward a report of a survey held on the above named vessel after grounding on the Island of Arran. They report the bottom examined in dry dock and found extensively damaged, about 85 shell plates being affected, as also the framing, girders and bulkheads in way of same.

An examination was also made by the Surveyors at the request of the Superintendent Engineer, with a view to making the necessary recommendations for the Special Survey No.3 which became due in July last.

The oil compartment specially examined for this purpose was No.8, in which the Surveyors report that the internal parts of the structure were found seriously deteriorated in places. The Surveyors further state that the other oil compartments appeared to be in a similar condition to that found in No.8.

The engine and boiler space, fore hold and all other spaces clear of the oil compartments were examined and found, with the exception of a few minor details, to be in good condition. The Surveyors state they have been informed by the Owners' Representative that it has been decided to sell the vessel to be broken up, and it is submitted the Owners
