I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant with reference to the account rendered by the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle for the Special Survey and classification of your Steamer "TREMERE" ex "AUGSBURG" and in reply, to explain that the fees in question are the same as have been charged and paid in many similar cases. I may point out that in the case of your Steamer "TREDENHAM" ex "FALKENFELS" which was submitted for classification by the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff, a similar amount was charged to your goodselves.

I may further remark that in the case of a new vessel with the same gross tonnage as the "TREMERE", the survey and classification fees if the steamer was built under special survey would now amount to
