We have received an account from your Tyne House for Special Survey & Classification of our s.s. "TREMERE" ex "AUGSBURG" amounting to £150. in addition to the £8. 8. 0. Board of Trade fee for Loadline &c. Whilst we are aware that this fee of £150. is less than that payable for new vessels, the services rendered in respect to a steamer already built surely could not approximate one half of a new steamer.

We have bought several ex-German vessels, and in the present state of the freight market this fee of £150. is an additional capital charge which we did not expect, and which was not considered at the time of purchase.
