It is respectfully submitted that suitable fees would be as follows: -

Machinery- £60.

We should further be glad to be informed whether any fee should be charged at this time in respect of the examination made in connection with the freeboard assignment.

We may add that it is understood the vessel has been re-measured for tonnage by the Board of Trade Authorities, but particulars of the new figures are not yet available.
