Dear Sirs,

With reference to the case of the steamer "DUMFRIES", which is at present laid up at Bideford, I have to inform you that I am now in receipt of a letter from the Owners in which they state that they are considering her sale to Italians, provided they can deliver the steamer to them with a Certificate of Seaworthiness to cover the voyage from Bideford to a Bristol Channel Loading port and thence to Italy with a cargo of coal where she would be broken up.

I enclose for your information a copy of a letter which I have today addressed to the Owners on the subject, and have to request that you will be good enough to give the case the necessary attention by carrying out a general examination of the hull, boilers and machinery in accordance with the provisions of Circular No.1605.

You will observe that the Owners have been informed that for the survey required a fee of £5:5:0, in addition to the travelling and incidental expenses will be charged in this case.
