Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th instant respecting your steamer "DUMFRIES", and with reference to the enquiry contained therein have to say that it is concluded that you desire the 3rd Special Survey No.2 to be calculated from the 3rd Special Survey No.1, which was passed at South Shields in August, 1929.

With regard thereto, I am directed to point out that the Society's Rules in connexion with the date at which Special Surveys become due are quite explicit, and this matter was explained to you in my letter of the 18th July last.

The Committee regret therefore they are unable to make the concession you desire, and if the vessel is to go into commission the survey will require to be carried out sometime within the year of grace, which, as already pointed out in my letter of the 22nd July last, expires at the end of June next.
