Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th instant respecting the steamer "DUMFRIES", and in reply to acquaint you that this case received the careful consideration of the Committee today who regret they are unable, consistently with the Society's Rules, to agree to your proposal to postpone the 3rd Special Survey No.2 until August, 1933. The Committee desire me to say, however, that provided the vessel be submitted to a general examination and favourably reported upon before she is again placed in commission, they will be agreeable to the inspection in question being carried out sometime within the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules, i.e. by the end of June next.

I have to add that in view of your intimation that the Boiler Survey will be carried out before the vessel is again placed in commission, the Committee have agreed to this inspection being postponed for the present.
