H. With reference to the 2nd Special Survey No.3 (after early First Special Survey No.3) which became due in January 1933 on the steamer "PAREORA" which has been laid up for some time past, I have to acquaint you that this vessel has recently been examined afloat and in drydock by the Society's Surveyors at Falmouth, Newport, Mon., and Barry, and as a result of general examination the Surveyors are of opinion that she is in a satisfactory condition to proceed with a perishable cargo from the United Kingdom to Japan to be broken up.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will be guided accordingly, and you will be so good as to advise me in due course as soon as the process of demolition is commenced.
