Ex-German S.S. "TREDENHAM" ex "FALKENFELS".

This vessel was built in Germany in 1915, and was examined in January last with a view to classification with this Society.

To entitle her to be classed with this Society some web frames require to be fitted, as compensation for deficiency in framing, and for the omission of two watertight bulkheads. It was arranged that the fitting of the web frames might be postponed until the vessel's arrival in the U.K., when these should be fitted and the requirements for classification carried out.

Messrs. The Hain S.S. Co. now write stating that at the moment they are desirous of negotiating a charter of the vessel, for which purpose it is necessary to describe her as being classed 100A1. They desire a reply today as to whether the Committee are in agreement with them describing the ship in this manner.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Owners be informed that provided web frames as already arranged to be fitted in the holds are fitted on the vessel's arrival in this country, and the tank connections examined and satisfactorily reported upon, the case could be recommended to the Committee for the class 100A1.
