ure of Survey

This vessel was built in 1915 and classed with Germanischer Lloyd.


The Cardiff Surveyors report the vessel has been placed in dry dock and examined throughout.

The bottom has been cleaned and coated and repairs due to damage and wear and tear effected.

The Committee's requirements for classification have been carried out except that web frames 36" x 10/20" require to be fitted in the holds as compensation for the framing being slightly deficient in strength, and for the omission of two bulkheads, and the connections at the margin plate require to be examined.

In the Surveyors' opinion the vessel is in a fit condition to run for a further period of six months.

It is submitted notation of Cff.1.21 be assigned, (see footnote 3).
