
With reference to the ex-German Steamer "FALKENFELS" now named "TREDENHAM", which has been under the survey of the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff with a view to classification in the Society's Register Book, I beg to acquaint you that the reports on this vessel have now been received, and it appears that it was not practicable on the present occasion to fit web frames in the holds as required to compensate for the framing being slightly deficient in strength and for the omission of two bulkheads. Further, the connections at the margin plate require to be examined.

In the circumstances, condition survey certificates in respect of the hull and machinery have been prepared by the Society's Surveyors to meet the case until the remaining requirements for classification have been complied with, and I have the pleasure to enclose these documents herewith, together with an account for the cost.
