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Gentlemen,

Replace Sailing Vessel No.256. Built by Messrs.
Ramage and Ferguson, Ltd.

I have to inform you that the Admiralty Accountant, during his investigation of costs of the above vessel, asked the builders to furnish him with a full list of the deviations from, and additions to, the original specification for vessel No.242, which had been embodied in the replace vessel No.256.

In reply, Messrs. Ramage & Ferguson stated that they preferred such request should be made through the Owners and I have accordingly to ask that you will authorize the builders to furnish the Admiralty, through the local Surveyor of Lloyd's Register, with the required list. It will be obvious that the Admiralty is unable to proceed with the question of final settlement of the cost of the replace vessel pending receipt of this information.

Copies of this letter are being transmitted to Messrs. Ramage & Ferguson Ltd. and to Lloyd's Register of Shipping.
